timetable you will find three main lessons a day with English and maths in the morning and one other subject in the afternoon. There are lots of other things throughout the day too that will keep you busy! We have planned in break times and lunch times on your timetable with suggested timings but we know you might not be able to stick to these. Do remember that it is important that you move about and keep yourself active during the day.



In the morning and in the afternoon you will be able to join a live lesson which means that you will see one of the teachers from your year group who will talk to you and your year group about the work you will be doing in English or maths and give you some help with this. They will stay online for 15 minutes at the end if you want to pop back into the meeting and ask any questions about the work. Year five and six 9:00 – 9:30, year three and year four 10:30 – 11:00.



In the afternoons, we will be having a story and review live session where we will be enjoying a story together and also going through some of your learning from the day. You will be able to see how you have got on with some of your work. Year five and six 2:00 – 2:30, year three and year four 3:00 – 3:20.

We will be using Google Meet for these live sessions and you will find the link to this meeting in your year group Google Classroom. Have a look at the guide to Google Meet before you click on the link so you know what to do.



Work as hard as you can each day and try to complete the activities that are set for you. Don't worry if you don't get through everything each day. Do not print out any of the resources but look at them online and, unless told otherwise, write down your work in your books that you have at home

Show us and celebrate what you have achieved each day by uploading a piece of your work/photo and emailing your class account so your teachers can see it.

We know that learning is going to be a bit different for a while but we know you are going to work hard and try your best. It will be lovely to see all your smiling faces on the screen until we can all meet together again in person.
