The Role:-

We are looking to appoint a full time LSA/INA to do 2 days a week supporting a child 1:1 as an INA and then the rest of the week as an LSA within the classroom. We would consider a 4 days contract for the right candidate.

As well as working with a child 1:1, you will be working with small groups of children to progress their academic learning and emotional wellbeing. We are looking for a good team player who loves working with children, is passionate about the development of the whole child and can use initiative whilst under pressure.

Please provide a personal statement of no more than one page highlighting your experience, examples of supporting children's learning and personal qualifications for the post. We would be interested to hear if you have any previous experience working with children who have SEND.
