3. All acts should be **NO LONGER THAN 2 mins 30 secs**

5. All acts **MUST** provide their own props, costumes and music on a CD or memory stick and must arrive dressed and ready to perform on the night.
6. The entry fee **MUST** be paid via ParentMail and you will be notified once the charge has been added to your account. Entry will cost £1.25 per person.
7. Successful applicants will be notified of their audition time.
8. The final successful acts taking part in the show will be notified by **Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2022**.
