The overall winners and runners up (one per year group) will be announced around 3.00pm. Winners will receive a £10 Out of Bounds voucher & Easter Egg and runners up will receive an Easter Egg and some goodies



### **Junior St Margaret's Bake Off Competition**

Junior children are invited to bake and decorate an Easter themed cake/ cupcakes. The cake can be baked by parents but **must be fully decorated by your child**. Your child should bring their cake into the bottom playground on the morning of Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April where the PTA Team will (weather permitting) have tables set up. Your child should then choose a sticker that says either, "to sell" or "to take home". **Please ensure cake storage boxes have stickers on with your child's name and class.**



The overall winners and runners up (one per year group) will be announced around 3.00pm. Winners will receive a £10 Out of Bounds voucher, A "Bake Off" wooden spoon keepsake and the runners up will receive an Easter Egg and some goodies.

Refreshments and cakes will be for sale during the afternoon. Any donations of cakes (homemade or shop bought) would be gratefully received.
