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Dear Parents and Carers

We are delighted to announce that we are able to offer parents the chance to see their children in Infant's Sports Morning this year on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June. Please see the details of the day attached, along with a zone map of parent/carer viewing zones.

However, in order to do this safely and in accordance with Covid-19 guidelines, we request the following guidelines are adhered to by **all** parents in attendance.

- Only **one parent/carer per family** can attend. This is to limit numbers in accordance with Government Guidelines. Please note that this also means **no siblings/ pre-schoolers can attend with parent.**
- Parents must wear masks and socially distance where possible.
- There will be NO toilets available for parent/carer use – please go before you leave home!
- Parents must stay in the designated areas – no running to give your winning child a cuddle I'm afraid!
- Parents with children in multiple year groups must stay in the designated areas (either the event area you are currently in, or the "waiting zone" if there is a delay (for example your children are YR and Y2).

Keeping parents in group bubbles of 30 or fewer is essential if we are to hold our sports days with parents on site. Staff will be present to help ensure a smooth transition from one event to the next.

## **Details of the Day and Viewing Zones**

Children should come to school in their PE kit and will remain in them for the day.

### **Events**

The morning will be split into two parts, with one class competing in the **Rotation Events** whilst the other competes at the **Track Event**.

### **ROTATION EVENTS – Held in centre of the running track:**

There will be 4 central events, all held in the centre of the running track

One class at a time will rotate (as a whole class) from Event 1 through to Event 4 whilst the other class will take part in the Track Event (see below) in house colours.

### **TRACK EVENT – Held on Running Track**

There will be a racing event on the running track. One class at a time will complete this event in House Colours.

Each year group will participate in their own sports morning with the following timings:

### **Reception**

**09:00 am – 10:00 am**

OAK class will start at the **ROTATION EVENT**

ASH class will start at the **TRACK EVENT**

### **Year 1**

**10:00 am – 11:00 am**

CHESTNUT class will start at the **ROTATION EVENT**

MAPLE class will start at the **TRACK EVENT**

### **Year 2**

**11:00 am – 12:00 pm**

CHERRY class will start at the **ROTATION EVENT**

WILLOW class will start at the **TRACK EVENT**

Parents should arrive via the green Arundel Road gate and make their way to the top playground/ field. Please make your way to the viewing zone your child's class will be starting in.

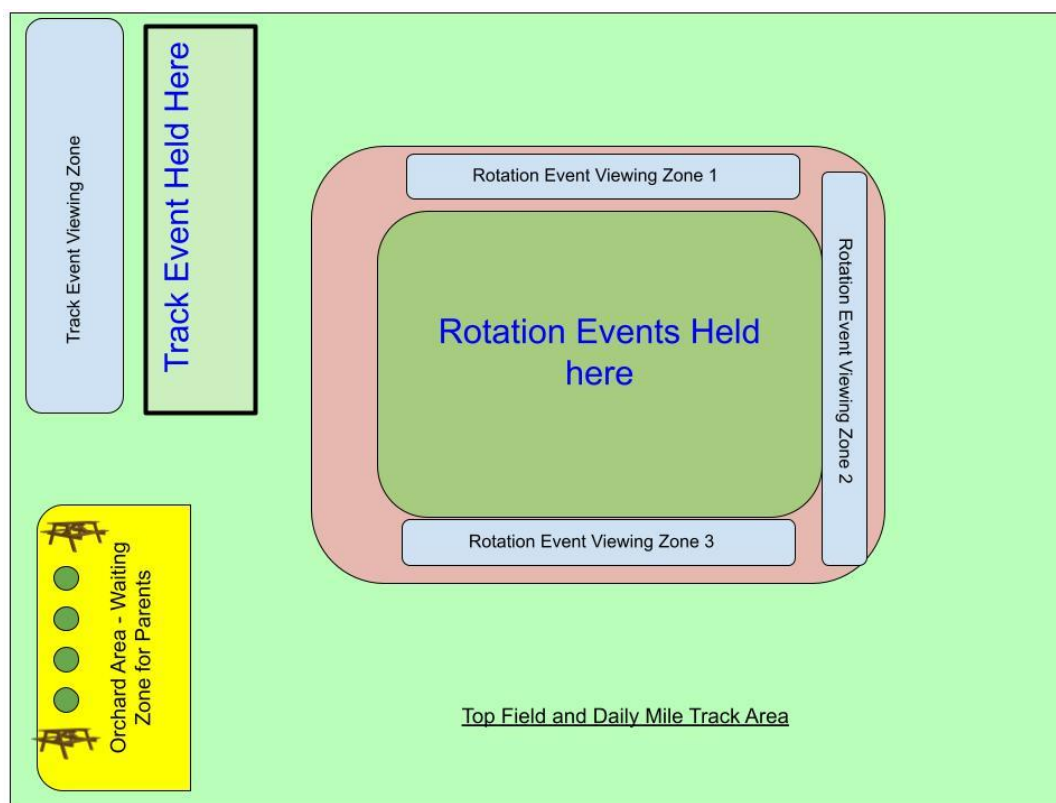
**Parent Viewing Areas (see map attached).**

Parents are to stand in the following designated areas, socially distanced:

**For Rotation Event** – To stand around the running track away from the track event side.

**For Track Event** – To stand along the side of the sprint track area, on the opposite side to the class competing.

If you are arriving for Year 1 or Year 2 event, please make your way to the “**waiting zone**” in the orchard area of the field to wait socially distanced whilst the previous year group spectators are dismissed.



Please be aware that those not adhering to the 1 parent per family and no pre-schooler rule **will be asked to leave the event**. We really appreciate your understanding and cooperation at this difficult time and we hope to be able to offer a much more family friendly day next year!
