May I remind you that Headteachers are NOT allowed by law to authorise absence in term time except for 'exceptional circumstances.' Children are in school for 190 days per year. Holidays in term time cannot be included as 'exceptional circumstances' except in very rare cases. As such Headteachers are not permitted to authorise such absences and the Local Authority (NOT the school) may issue a fine.




And finally After a busy half term we wish everyone a safe and restful break. We look forward to seeing you on Monday 30^{th} October.
