Building Works – The Tomlin Centre

The building works are nearing completion with the playground due to be tarmacked shortly. This will be a challenging week for drop off and pick up so please read this section carefully.

The pavement by the Arundel Road gate is to be reinstated from the last week of term - Monday 11th December. There will be traffic lights installed and the crossing patrol area will be further up Arundel Road as on previous occasions. This gate will not be available for the final week of term.

Children in Years 2, 4, 5 & 6 should come into school via the main entrance and then come into the school building via the school office (sliding doors). Bikes can be left in a designated area for them to collect at the end of the day.

During the last week of term, drop off and collection for children in Years R, Year 1 and Year 3 will be the same. Year 2 can also be collected from the Year 1 classrooms a little after Year 1 have been released. Years 4, 5 and 6 will leave school via the main office sliding doors.
