Drop off and Pick Up Arrangements - a reminder

The building work for the Tomlin Centre is now finished! From Monday 5th February:-

The start of the school day is 8.40am.

- Years 1 and 2 can come through the silver gate from 8.30am onwards **TOGETHER** ie. Year 2 do **not** need to wait until 8.40am. Year 2 can walk to class unaccompanied.
- Years 4, 5 and 6 can come through the Arundel Road Green Gates from 8 30am.
- Year 3 can come into school from 8.30am via their usual gate.
- Reception can come into school via their usual gate from 8.40am.


These arrangements allow working parents to drop off earlier and parents with children in Infants and Juniors will have less waiting time.

All children MUST be in school by 8.40pm or they will be late.

Years R-2 finish lessons at 3.00pm.

Years 3-6 finish lessons at 3.05pm.

Parents can come in to collect children from either gate at the end of the day.

Attendance

We are aware that children can be absent for a variety of unavoidable reasons but that some parents may not be aware of just how these have accumulated. This letter is for information only. Please contact the school if you would like support with your child's attendance.

Absence in Term Time

Headteachers are not permitted to authorise holiday in term time and any authorisation should be for "exceptional" circumstances only. Please refrain from booking holidays in term time – we cannot make up lost learning. It's a sobering thought that an attendance rate of 90% (1 days absence each fortnight) equates to a year of lost education over 10 years.

We have been asked to circulate this information to parents and carers:-

"Cases of measles are rising across England, including among children and young people. The symptoms of measles, along with more information about the virus, can be found on the NHS website.

The Department for Education has published new advice for managing measles outbreaks, including advice for parents on what to do when they suspect their child may have measles.
