Dear Parents and Carers,

This year Infant Sports Morning will be held on Monday 23rd June; it will take the same format as last year. Please see the details of the day attached, along with a zone map of parent/carer viewing zones.

Details of the Day and Viewing Zones

Children should have their PE kit at school and will change on site when they arrive at school.

Events

The morning will be split into two parts, all year groups will compete in the **Rotation Events** followed by the **Running Track Event**.

ROTATION EVENTS – Held in centre of the running track:

There will be 6 central events, all held in the centre of the running track.

All year groups will rotate (in mixed year groups) from Event 1 through to Event 6 and then they will move to the running track.

TRACK EVENT – Held on Running Track

There will be running races for each class followed by a year 1 girls and boys long distance and then a year 2 girls and boys long distance race.

10:40am – 11:10 – Track Events


