

English Learning

We will be learning to:

- Write a recount of an event that we have taken part in by explaining what happened in a logical order.
- Create an information leaflet with questions and historical information in an exciting layout.
- Write a fictional diary account (based on diary accounts from the time of the Great Fire of London) including immersive description based on drama work.

Mathematical Learning

- 3D Geometry: Name of some 3D shapes and to count how many faces, edges and vertices they have.
- Statistics: Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables and ask and answer questions about totalling and comparing categorical data.
- Position and direction: Use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement e.g. rotations, right angles for quarter, half and three-quarter turns (clockwise and anticlockwise).
- Time: Tell and write the time to five minutes including quarter past/to
 the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. To
 know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day
 and to compare and sequence intervals of time.

We will also be recapping on:

- adding and subtracting two digit numbers
- counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100

PSHE Learning

We will be focusing on wellbeing, developing an awareness and understanding of other people's feelings and emotions, investigating strategies for dealing with difficult situations and emotions and learning about growth mindset.

Scientific Learning

Our topic this term is plants. We will learn about:

- The life cycle of plants
- What seeds are made of and what conditions they need to grow
- The parts of a plant, including those that we eat

Art Learning

Our art this half term is based around the Great Fire of London. We will be developing our skills with chalk pastels and experimenting with visual elements, line, shape, pattern and colour.



Music Learning

Our unit for this half term is called Friendship Song. Within, the children will listen to and appraise a variety of friendship songs, take part in some musical activities and have the chance to perform in front of one another.

Faith and Wonder Learning



We will be looking at the faith of Judaism. We will learn about their holy book, the Torah, the special rules that the Jews follow to look after it and the festival of Simchat Torah.

Computing Learning

We will be continuing to use the Scratch Jr app to carrying out an informed cycle of predicting, testing, reviewing, program a familiar story and an animation of an animal. In our half termly computer safety lesson we will also be learning strategies that will help us decide if something we see online is true or not.

PE Learning

This half term, we will be focusing on dance and celebration in honour of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

In outdoor PE, we will be teaching a range of athletic skills.



How can you help?

- Continuing to listen to your child read regularly and discuss the book with them afterwards. Please can an <u>adult</u> write in the reading diary to show when the child has read and how they did. We are rewarding this with stickers to promote regular reading.
- Lots of regular practice of maths learning tasks, as explained on your child's homework.
- Supporting your child with learning their spellings, discussing the meanings of words and ways of remembering the spelling patterns.
