#### English Learning

In English, we will be reading 'Mad About Minibeasts' by Giles Andreae and David Wojtowycz. We will learn:

- \* about the features of poetry, including rhyme and alliteration
- \* to write our own poem about minibeasts using these features

We will also write about the differences between holidays now and holidays in the past, including how to use conjunctions to compare and contrast.

#### Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at:

- \* Multiplication and division recalling our times table facts and using these to answer division questions; drawing arrays to help us multiply and divide other numbers
- \* Measurement reading numbers on different types of scales; telling the time to the nearest 15 minutes (o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to) and then to the nearest 5 minutes.

#### PSHE Learning

This half term we will be learning about how we change as we grow up.





## Scientific Learning

Our topic this term is plants. We will learn about:

- \* The life cycle of plants
- \* What seeds of made of and what conditions they need to grow into plants
- \* The parts of a plant, including those that we eat

#### Art Learning

We will be looking at seashells. This will include close observational sketching of the patterns on seashells. We will also design and create a tile with a seashell pattern and use this to print pictures.

#### Music Learning

We will be practising songs for the 'Little Big Sing'. This is a musical workshop involving Year 2 children from various schools in the locality.

## Faith and Wonder Learning

We will be looking at the topic of Judaism. We will learn about the importance of the story of Moses to Jews and about Jewish practices and beliefs.

## Computing Learning

We will be learning how to program devices such as Bee-Bots. We will also learn how to create graphs to show data on a computer.

#### PE Learning

We will be focusing on dance, learning our routine for May Day.



# How can you help?

- Continuing to listen to your child read regularly, and discuss the book with them afterwards.
- Lots of regular practice of Maths learning tasks, as explained on your child's homework.
- Supporting your child with learning their spellings, discussing the meanings of words and ways of remembering the spelling patterns.
