English Learning

In English, we will be studying the story The Iron Man written by Ted Hughes. We will be learning:

- To respond to a text giving our thoughts and feelings about what has happened, what we like or don't like, how we feel about the characters etc. Ted Hughes
- How to use commas effectively when needing to add extra information.
- To use exciting and adventurous language to create a menu for the Iron Man.
- To recap on the features of a newspaper and write one linked to the story of the Iron Man.

Mathematical Learning



This term we are looking at:

- Adding and subtracting fractions, understanding equivalent fractions and ordering fractions.
- Telling the time to the nearest minute including understanding past and to the o'clock.
- Finding time differences.
- Right angles in shapes and comparing different angles.
- The differences between parallel and perpendicular lines.



PSHCE Learning

We will be learning about what makes a healthy family and how to solve conflicts within friendships. We will also be talking about who to trust and respecting differences in others.

French Learning

We will be learning the names of some of the most popular fruits. We will be able to say fruits that we like and don't like, as well as asking questions about other people's likes and dislikes.

Scientific Learning



Our topic this half term will be Light and Shadows.

- We will recognise that we need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- We will notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- We will recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.
- We will recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect our eyes.

How can you help?

- Continuing to listen to your child read regularly at home, with lots of discussion about the book. Please ensure that you write a comment in your child's reading diary with a focus on their fluency and understanding of the text. As part of their homework we expect the children to read at least five times a week for 10-15 minutes.
- Lots of regular times table testing for the 2, 3, 4, 5, 10 and 8 times tables. The faster the response, the better! Using Times Table Rockstars at least 4 times a week will really help with your child's recall.
- Supporting your child with learning their spellings, discussing the meanings of words, putting them into sentences and reviewing spellings from previous weeks.
