English Learning

In English, we will be studying the story, The Iron Man written by Ted Hughes. We will be learning:

* To respond to a text giving our thoughts and feelings about what has happened, what we like or don't like, how we feel about the characters etc.

* How to use commas effectively when needing to add extra information.

* To use exciting and adventurous language to create a menu for the Iron Man.



* To recap on the features of a newspaper and write one linked to the story of the Iron Man.

Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at fractions. Learning about:

- * recognising and finding halves, quarters and thirds
- * equivalent fractions
- * comparing, adding and subtracting fractions
- * finding fractions of objects and sets

PSHE Learning

We will be finishing our work on Citizenship and starting a new unit on economic wellbeing (thinking about spending, budgeting and how spending affects others).

French Learning

We will be covering the unit Je Peux where we will learn how to say short sentences about what we can do.

Scientific Learning



Our topic this half term will be Light and Shadows.

- * We will recognise that we need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- * We will notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- * We will recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.
- * We will recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.

Art Learning

We will learn how robot drawings are created using a ruler and we will create our own 3D robot art using nets of shapes.

<u>Music Learning</u>

We will looking at the unit Bringing Us Together where we will learn about a disco song about friendship, peace, hope and unity.

Faith and Wonder Learning

We are learning about religious art: thinking about how and why religions use art and the different ways of expressing meaning and spirituality.

Computing Learning

We will be learning about how to plan and film a video trailer for a book. The children will be learning to use imovie to film and edit their book trailers.

PE Learning



Badger Class will be working with Mr Mayne this half term on Friday afternoons in a low low develop team work skills, problem solving and will also be covering elements of First Aid. He will work with Otter Class next half term.

Otter Class will be looking at a striking and fielding unit of work for their outdoor sessions.

We will be learning:
