English Learning

In English, we will be studying the story, The Iron Man written by Ted Hughes. We will be learning:

- * To respond to a text giving our thoughts and feelings about what has happened, what we like or don't like, how we feel about the characters etc.
- * How to use commas effectively when needing to add extra information.
- * To use exciting and adventurous language to create a menu for the Iron Man.
- * To recap on the features of a newspaper and write one linked to the story of the Tron Man

Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at:

- * Place value, understanding what each digit means in three digit number and solving problems involving this.
- *Counting in 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 50 and 100s
- * Mental and written methods for adding and subtracting two and three digit numbers.
- * Written methods for multiplication and division.
- *Learning 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables so we can answer them at speed.

PSHCE Learning

We will be learning about how to have a Growth Mindset and how to keep ourselves safe.

French Learning

We will be recapping on how to name different pets that we might have at home and begin to learn the names of colours.

Scientific Learning

Our topic this half term will be Light and Shadows.

- * We will recognise that we need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- * We will notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- * We will recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.
- * We will recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.

Art Learning

We will learn how robot drawings are created using a ruler and we will create our own 31 robot art using nets of shapes.

Music Learning

We will continue with our studies of choral singing and singing in a round. We will particularly be looking at the song about the Mexican volcano 'Popocatepetl'.

Faith and Wonder Learning

We are learning about religious art: thinking about how and why religions use art and the different ways of expressing meaning and spirituality.

Computing Learning

We will be learning about how to program. We will design, write and debug programs tha accomplish specific goals, use sequence, selection, and repetition in programs.

PE Learning

We will be practising the skills needed for May Day dancing and will start a unit of athletics work in preparation for our Sports Morning.











How can you help?

- Continuing to read regularly at home to an adult, with lots of discussion about the book.
- Lots of regular times table testing for the 2, 3, 4, 5, 10 and 8 times tables. The faster the response, the better!
- Supporting your child with learning their spellings, discussing the meanings of words, putting them into sentences and reviewing spellings from previous weeks.
