English Learning

In English, we will be studying the story, Escape from Pompeii by Christina Balit. We will be learning:

- To respond to a text, giving our thoughts and feelings about what has happened, what we like or don't like, how we feel about the characters etc POMPEII
- To plan and write a recount in role as a given character
- To plan and write poems
- About the features of leaflets and how to plan and create one

Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at:

- Counting in 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 50 and 100s
- Written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Measurement, comparing and adding mass and volume/capacity
- Recognising angles and pairs of perpendicular and parallel times in 2D shapes
- Learning 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables so we can answer them at speed



PSHCE Learning

We are learning about Family and Relationships and Safety and the Changing Body.

French Learning

We are learning about the Red Riding Hood story as well as looking at the different parts of the body.



Scientific Learning

Our topic this half term will be Plants. We will:

- Learn about the different parts of flowering plants and be able to explain their functions
- Investigate how water is transported in plants and ٠ understand that plants make their own food from sunlight, water and carbon dioxide
- Learn about the life cycle of a flowering plant

Art Learning

We will look closely at Roman artwork and creating our own Roman mosaic using paper.



Music Learning

We will continue to use Charanga to support our learning of pulse, rhythm and pitch.

Computing Learning

We are using Google Slides to create presentations with key facts and images about Roman life.


PE Learning
