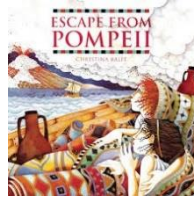


English Learning

In English, we will be studying the story, Escape from Pompeii by Christina Balit. We will be learning:

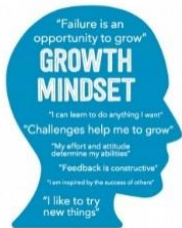
- To respond to a text, giving our thoughts and feelings about what has happened, what we like or don't like, how we feel about the characters etc
- To plan and write a recount in role as a given character
- To plan and write poems
- About the features of leaflets and how to plan and create one



Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at:

- Measurement, comparing and adding mass and volume/capacity
- Recognising angles and pairs of perpendicular and parallel times in 2D shapes
- Learning 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables so we can answer them at speed
- Telling the time to 5 minutes and use the 24 hour clock



PSHE Learning

We are looking at economic wellbeing and transitioning.

French Learning

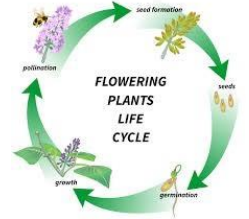
We are learning about the Red Riding Hood story as well as looking at the different parts of the body.



Scientific Learning

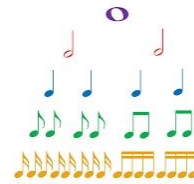
Our topic this half term will be Plants. **We will:**

- Learn about the different parts of flowering plants and be able to explain their functions
- Investigate how water is transported in plants and understand that plants make their own food from sunlight, water and carbon dioxide
- Learn about the life cycle of a flowering plant



Art Learning

We will look closely at Roman artwork and creating our own Roman mosaic using paper.



Music Learning

We will continue to use Charanga to support our learning of pulse, rhythm and pitch.



Computing Learning

We will be learning about how record and sort out data using our iPad and Chromebook.

PE Learning

Otter Class will be working with Mr Mayne this half term on Friday afternoons to develop team work skills, problem solving and will also be covering elements of First Aid. He will work.

Badger Class will be looking at a striking and fielding unit and athletics for their outdoor sessions.

Faith and Wonder Learning

We are learning about the 'People of God', from the Old Testament, the covenant made with God by Noah, and thinking what that means for Christians and Jews to follow God today.

How can you help?

- Supporting your child with learning their spellings, discussing the meanings of words, putting them into sentences and reviewing spellings from previous weeks

Sports Day is Friday 1st July starting at 9:30am

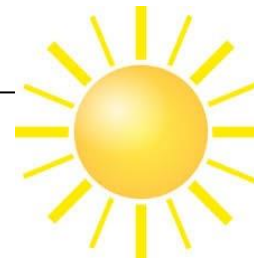
