English Learning

In English, we will be thinking about grammar, and learning to write letters and instructions. We will:


- * Be thinking about different types of sentences

- * Measuring angles

Scientific Learning

Our topic this half term will be Habitats. We will learn:



- About the different habitats of living things

Design and Technology Learning

We will be making a storybook with moving parts (pop-up book) based around the Loch Ness monster

Music Learning

We will be continuing with our tenor horn lessons.



Faith and Wonder Learning We will be looking at Gospel and thinking

Computing Learning

Researching and storing data using spreadsheets; designing a weather station that gathers and records data; learning how weather forecasts are made.
