
#### **English Learning**

In English, we will be looking at the text Street Child (linked to the Victorians). We will:



- activities linked to the story Write a diary as the main character
- Find out about the origins of the story and its links to the charity Barnardo's.

We will then look at the work of Charles Dickens. We will learn:

- To read and follow a play script
- To perform a scene from Oliver Twist
- To summarise a Dickens's story

#### Mathematical Learning

This half term we are looking at:

- Addition and subtraction formal methods.
- Formal methods for multiplication and division
- Statistics and interpreting data
- Consolidating number and place value

#### PSHE Learning

We will be focusing on the unit Health and Wellbeing in our PSHE lessons this half term.





## French Learning

Our unit is 'Chez Moi' and the class will be learning to say the names of different homes in French.

#### **Scientific Learning**

Our topic this half term will be properties of materials. We will:

- Investigate insulators and conductors
- Look at the process of evaporation and learn about which changes that are reversible
- Look at how to separate materials using a variety of methods

We will be looking at silhouette portraits and framing.

#### Music Learning

We will be learning about Nursery Rhymes as part of our Victorian topic.



#### Faith and Wonder Learning

We will be looking at the unit "Incarnation" this half term.

### Computing Learning

We will be working on learning and improving our programming skills, with the help of the coding programme *Scratch*.

### **PE Learning**

For our Indoor PE lesson we will continue to go swimming every Friday to build water confidence and swimming technique. In Outdoor PE we will be learning a range of skills linked with invasion type games.



How can you help?

- Encourage your child to read regularly at home, both independently and to an adult. Comprehension is a key part of the children's reading development so asking lots of questions when you hear your child read is really beneficial for this.
- Lots of regular times table testing including both multiplication and division facts.
- Supporting your child with learning their spellings, discussing the meanings of words, discussing the phoneme and any spelling rules, and reviewing spellings from previous weeks.
