English Learning

We will be focusing on the unit Health and Wellbeing in our PSHE lessons this half term. We will also learn about global events including Anti-Bullying Week and Black History Month.




French Learning

We will be looking at our Judaism unit on 'What symbols and stories help Jewish people remember their covenant with God.'




Computing Learning
