English Learning

In English, we will be completing our studies of Sophie Anderson's The House with Chicken Legs. We will be focusing on non-fiction and information texts as well as practising our prose and poetry writing, as well as learning performance skills. We will be:

- Writing information texts about characters and events in the story
- Learning about characterisation and narrative
- Learning skills to perform our stories and poetry



Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at:

- * Different types of angles, naming these and estimating them
- * Measuring angles using a protractor
- * Consolidating understanding of the four formal operations
- * A range of fraction questions, their equivalent decimals and percentages.

PSHE Learning

We will continue to learn about Citizenship, thinking about Responsibility, Community and Democracy.



Computing Learning

We will be working on our word processing skills. Improving our typing skills, which will involve looking at hand positions, knowledge of letter and symbol location to increase typing speed and accuracy.



Scientific Learning

Our topics this half term will be Life Cycles and Habitats and Forces. We will learn:

- The forces at work on our planet and in the universe
- About the different types of life in our world
- How different animals are suited to their habitats
- About the life cycles of different animals from different classes of the animal kingdom



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We will be continuing to explore the concepts of

light, colour, shape, space and texture with our new topic question: "Is there colour without light?". We will be using different media and studying the work of artists from all around the world and using our skills to create our own artwork for an exhibition.

Music Learning

We will be using the music program Charanga to learn how music connects us to our past, studying the music of different artists and performing pieces of our own.



Faith and Wonder Learning

We will be looking at 'The people of God' and thinking about our big question, 'How can following God bring freedom and justice?'

<u>PE Learning</u>

Lewes will be focusing on Athletics this half term - we will be working on our jumping, throwing and running techniques. Amberley will be working on their teamwork skills and knowledge of first aid with Mr Mayne.
