English Learning

In English, firstly we will be reading the story of King Kong. We will learn:

- About jobs by writing a job advert for a leading lady for a new film
- To use language for choice by coming up with our own prehistoric creature and writing a fight scene between it and King Kong
- To predict what we think will happen next in the story
- To write our own ending to the story



Secondly, we will be looking at pirates! We will learn:

- About jobs on board ship by using our drama skills, writing persuasive letters and interviewing someone for a job
- To take notes, write these into sentences and produce our fact sheets
- To continue to edit our writing and publish this

Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at:

- Prime, square and cubed numbers
- Finding non-unit fractions of quantities
- Comparing areas and calculating the areas of rectangles
- How to read, write and convert time between analogue and digital clocks
- Formal methods for multiplication and division
- Solving problems by showing our working out

PSHE Learning

We will be learning about Safety and the Changing Body.

French Learning

We will be learning about fruits.



Scientific Learning

Our topic this half term will be Stages of Life. We will learn:

- To describe the differences in lifecycles of mammals
- To describe the stages of the lifecycle of an amphibian
- To describe the lifecycles of insects and birds
- To understand the terms complete metamorphosis and incomplete metamorphosis
- To begin to know the parts of a plant
- To know the lifecycle of a plant
- To describe the life process of reproduction in some plants

Art Learning (linked to the Vikings)

We will develop our skills using a range of 3D materials including clay and using water colour paints to produce work related to the Vikings.

<u>Music Learning</u>

We will be learning about different sea shanties, singing some and writing our own.

Faith and Wonder Learning

We will be looking at the Gospel part of the Big Story of the Bible.

Computing Learning

We will be looking at coding programs, particularly Scratch.

<u>PE Learning</u>

We will be continuing to develop striking and fielding skills. We will be looking at skills used in athletics.
