

English Learning

In English, we will be reading "The Nowhere Emporium" by Ross McKenzie and "Blue John" by Berlie Doherty. We will be using these as the basis for our own creative story writing. In our guided reading sessions, we will be reading and discussing "Holes" by Louis Sachar.

Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at fractions, decimals and percentages, and introducing algebra.



PSHE Learning

In PSHE our topic will be "Safety and the Changing Body". This will include some basic First Aid knowledge: how to conduct a primary survey, how to help someone who is choking, how to place someone in the recovery position and how to give CPR.



French Learning


We will be learning vocabulary for objects "en classe" (in the classroom).



Scientific Learning

This half term we are finishing our learning about evolution and inheritance. Then we will be moving on to our topic of electricity. We will be:

- Learning about electrical components and their circuit symbols
- Drawing circuit diagrams and explaining why they are complete or incomplete
- Using various materials to create different types of switches



Music Learning

We will be developing our skills at playing, improvising and composing on the glockenspiel in a range of styles, including disco.

Faith and Wonder Learning

We will be looking at Hinduism:

- Key Hindu beliefs and practices
- The significance of the "aum" symbol.
- Hindu gods
- Beliefs about reincarnation



Computing Learning

We will be learning about online safety (establishing a positive online reputation) and creating mathematical patterns using programming languages.

PE Learning

In Outdoor PE, we will be playing volleyball; in Indoor PE we will be exploring different styles of dance.

- Continuing to read regularly for sustained period of time (at least 20 minutes, 5 times a week).
