
English Learning


In English, we will be focusing on Poetry and continuing our class book The Nowhere Emporium. Our poetry work will lead on to debating and writing a persuasive speech.


French Learning

This half term we will be continuing our focus on electricity. We will be learning how switches and why are used in circuits and using our understanding to construct a pressure-sensitive alarm.




Design Technology Learning
