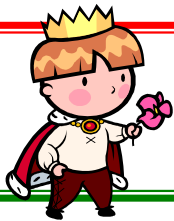


## P.S.E.D

- Who would you be if you were in a fairy tale? What you be nasty, kind, scary etc? Why?

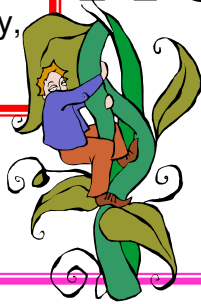


## Mathematics

- Counting jewels – matching numbers to their numerals.
- Patterns
- Using dice and making sets, which has more/less.
- Recognising numbers
- Symmetry
- Positional language

## Expressive Arts and Design

- Paint characters' from stories
- Make shields and crowns
- Sewing on an apple
- Class/group pictures of Three Little Pigs and their houses.
- Sew a stuffed pig.
- Make a wolf (splits pins for hinged mouth)
- Junk modelling giants castle or jacks house.
- Val Sabin dance
- Music express.



## Physical Development

- Val Sabin Games - focus on medium size balls
- Val Sabin gymnastics – Unit A focus on travelling.
- Gross motor activities such as riding bikes, playing in the sand, circle games.
- Fine motor Activities including pencil play, dough disco, threading, etc.

## Literacy

- Reading stories from home about Princesses and Castles (eg :Sleeping Beauty, Frog Princess) Describe characters, talk about story book language.
- The Gingerbread Man - Act out story.
- News Writing
- The three little pigs – writing signs for the construction site (role play)
- Jack and the beanstalk, making wanted posters for Jack / The Giant. Writing signs and labels.
- Snow White and the Seven Dwarves – sequencing pictures to tell the story.



# Traditional Tales Early Years

## Understanding of the World

- Discuss how stories change of time (this is why there are different ending in different versions)
- Making Gingerbread Men – how do ingredients change as they are put together & cooked?
- Talk about and draw maps & pictures to compare differences between the places characters in fairy tales live and where we live.
- The story of Guy Fawkes - talk about Bonfire Night.
- RE focus on Jesus childhood – homes and carrying water.
- RE focus on jobs in Jesus time - Zacchaeus, tax collector, Fisherman and Carpenter
