







<u>English</u>

<p><b>Spelling</b></p> 	<p>Try to learn the first four words for this week's spellings; using the methods we use at school. LOOK COVER WRITE GOLD: adoration, preparation, relegation, exaggeration SILVER: information, sensation, education, location BRONZE: middle, apple, little, simple, today Get an adult or another child to test you</p>
