






Year 4 - Monday 13th July 2020

<u>English</u>	
Reading 	Try to do some reading out loud this week. You may have some funny poetry or joke books that you can use to make some people in your household laugh. Or you could find some jokes or limericks online and say them out loud.
Spelling 	Try the spelling crosswords that I have sent to the school website. All the words come from the year/3/4 spelling lists. The later ones give you some clues so are easier to work out! Print out only the ones you need. A bit of fun for the last week. (You can check the answers afterwards)
English 	Write a postcard to someone in the class you know. The language needs to be informal and chatty. It does not need to be long or wordy! You may start with "Hi "and finish with "See you soon" It would be great if you could send it (ask your friend for their address). (You could buy an actual postcard or make one with your own drawn image on the back.) At the beginning of next term we can bring these postcards into school.
