Note the author of your book - find out three facts about them and make a list of other books they've written. Are there any similarities?

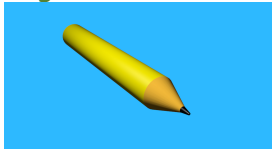
Spelling
