







<p>English</p> 	<p>Create a treasure hunt around the house or garden.</p> <p>Use verbs, adverbs and adjectives to describe each clue... for example 'Lift the small, grey stone carefully and check underneath...'</p> <p>Ask an adult to check your sentences to make sure they make sense, are spelt correctly and have used appropriate punctuation. Have fun!</p>
<p>Reading</p> 	<p>Read some of your reading book and write in your reading diary. Who is your favourite character and why?</p>
<p>Spelling</p> 	<p>Choose 4 spellings from the Year 3 and 4 lists to practise. Write them out 3 times and if you are unsure of their meanings, look them up and write these down too.</p>
<p>Mental Maths</p> 	<p>Check out https://www.coolmathgames.com/ for some fun maths games!</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Write out your 10x and 5x tables and their division factors - can you go beyond the usual x12? What patterns can you spot between these tables?</p>
<p>Cooking</p> 	<p>Make some jelly, if you have some at home! Carefully check the measurements...</p> <p>Alternatively, make up a revolting recipe with jelly in it! Use alliteration and adjectives to make it as disgusting as you like and remember to use realistic amounts of ml, grams etc</p> <p>Photograph if possible and put in your home learning book.</p>
