Reading	Read some of your reading book and write in your reading diary. Think about what you have read and write some questions that you could answer. Write your questions and your answers in your red book.
Spelling	Today we would like to you think about HOMOPHONES. These are words that sound the same, but have different spellings or meanings. Try to think of as many as you can and create a word search with them in.
English task	We have now finished gathering the information for our non-fiction book. Today we are going to create the contents page and the back cover. Have a look at the writing frame for the Contents Page and complete or create one of your own - your pages can go in any order that you like!  When you have finished this, have a look at the Back Cover writing frame and write a blurb, add a price and maybe even a quote from someone who has 'read' your book. Again you can either print out the template, or create one of your own.
	Maths
Mental maths	Play times table rock star <b>OR</b> Attack the times tables! Write all the answers to either the 3, 4 or 8 times table on post it notes or slips of paper and lay them on
	the floor. Get someone to ask you a times table and you can jump on the correct answer or shot them with a nerf gun etc. Or you could write them with chalk on the floor outside and shot them with a water gun. If there is no one who could ask you a question, write the questions on cards and turn them over one at a time or use playing cards. See the video on Google Classroom to help.
Maths task  or rectangle triangle oval	<u>2D shapes - Watch video https://vimeo.com/432264925</u> Complete one of these tasks: *The work sheet 'Recognise-and-describe-2D-shapes' on our website * Create a picture using different 2D shapes. You could draw them with a ruler or draw around objects to help you with this. Write how many different shapes are in
rhombus pentagon square heptagon kite	that picture.  * Describe shape to someone and they have to guess what shape you are describing e.g. it has four sides, two are longer than the other two, it has two parallel lines and two perpendicular lines, it has 4 right angles etc.  There is a 2D shape poster to help.

Subject 2: DT	It's now time to make your Roman Catapult! Yay! Follow the instructions uploaded to the website to make either a pyramid or lever catapult and fill in page 5 of the design booklet. Then test out your catapult by firing your marshmallow and seeing how far it travels. Use a tape measure or ruler to measure the actual distance. Record your 3 distances on page 6 in the design

booklet and then upload your best distance travelled to Google Classroom. Let's
