Spelling Choose 4 spellings from either the Year 1 and 2 or 3 and 4 lists to practise. Write them out 3 times and if you are unsure of their meanings, look them up and write these down too. Play a game of hangman with them or create a word search with these words in. Get someone in your family to find the words. English task Think back to the character you designed which could have appeared in Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. Today we would like you to plan out a missing chapter which includes your character and what happens to them. Divide a piece of plain paper up in to 6 equal boxes. In each box DRAW the following and label them with your own ideas and phrases. Remember to include adjectives (describing words), verbs (doing words), adverbs (words which describe how something is done) and similes e.g. it munched her up like a hungry lion. 1.
