





Year 3 - Thursday 21st May 2020

<u>English</u>	
Reading 	<p>Over the next week, try to read at least 3 times and write in your reading diary. If you have time, and it is a new book, why not complete another book review. It may be sent to Ms Dark, who will then choose some to feature on our website.</p> <p>Read the next part of The Iron Man to help with your English task.</p>
Spelling 	<p>Today, we would like to you think about what happens when you add the prefix 'dis' to words. What do you already know about words that begin with 'dis'? Can this prefix be added to any word? Have a go at selecting some words that 'dis' can be added to and think about what type of words these are. Write them in your red book in your best joined handwriting and then play hangman with them.</p>
English task 	<p>Read the next part of chapter 2 of The Iron Man. The text will be uploaded to Google Classroom - it's quite long so you may want to share the reading with an adult! Think about Hogarth's few days since spotting the Iron Man. We are now going to have a go at planning and writing a diary entry as Hogarth.</p> <p>Plan</p> <p>Divide a page in to 6 boxes and draw in the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Getting up and going fishing2. Seeing Iron Man3. Running back home and telling his parents4. Dad tells 1st farmer and he laughs5. Dad tells 2nd farmer and he believes6. All farmers dig a massive hole to trap Iron Man <p>Add in any key words that you might want to use.</p> <p>Writing</p> <p>Remember that when you write a journal, it is written in the first person so you need to imagine that you are writing as if you are Hogarth. Try to include how you are feeling and what you are thinking as a small boy having witnessed this Iron Man coming to your village/town and the trap being set. Write your journal entries in your red book or type them up. If you want to, share them on Google Classroom.</p>
<u>Maths</u>	
Mental maths 	<p>Play Times Tables Rock Star. We are inviting you to attempt a World wide Guinness World Records title by answering as many times tables questions correctly as you can in one minute. Please see the extra sheet for more information.</p>
Maths task	<p><u>Money, money, money!! Adding money</u></p> <p>If possible, use some real money or play money to help you. Real money is better to use if possible as it feels and weighs different from play money</p>

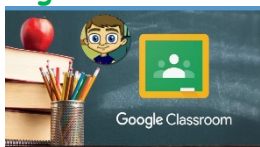
