English	Look at this picture of Charlie Bucket's house. Draw your own picture of it and create labels using adjectives and similes to describe it.
Reading	Read some of your reading book and write in your reading diary. Use your bookmark to answer 2 questions.
Spelling Stelling	Choose 4 spellings from either the Year 1 and 2 or 3 and 4 lists to practise. Write them out 3 times and if you are unsure of their meanings, look them up and write these down too.
Mental Maths	Play on Times Table Rock Stars and Hit the Button. Add your score in to your red book.
Maths	Can you draw a line or an object which is 4cm long? How many mm long is it? What do you notice? Can you draw something which is 7.5cm long? How many mm is it? Try drawing a line/object which is 65mm? How many cm long is it? Try another 3 examples. Can you write a sentence describing how to convert between cm and mm? <u>Want stretching - try the Rocket Challenge</u> - Try this challenge. Then, can you convert between m (meters), cm and mm. Can you explain what the relationship is between them? You could make up your own problems like this. Who is the tallest? What is Aland's height in centimetres?
Topic – Geographical Study	Can you find out about what the village/town you live in was like in
	the past? Maybe you could chat to an older relative or neighbour on the phone or over the internet.
