
Plants Depend on Animals.



Pollen

 Plants depend on insects like bees to spread pollen from flower to flower.
This helps the plants make seeds to grow new plants.



Acorns fall from the tree and sprout

 If they are not eaten or damaged by animals, acorns can sprout quickly after falling from the tree. **Eventually** becoming a new tree.



Animals spreading hooked seeds

 Some kinds of plant use hooks on their seeds to attach themselves to the fur of animals or feathers of birds. When the animal travels the seed falls off making a new plant in a different place.





Animal burial

- Hard nuts are usually destroyed if chewed or eaten.
- However, animals such as squirrels may store them to eat later and forget to go back to get them, giving them a chance to sprout and grow into a new tree.

Plants from soft fruit seeds.

•The seeds of many plants are spread after passing through animals that have eaten the fruits. The seeds still grow into new plants!
