Reading

Don't forget your punctuation (including the possessive apostrophe on dragon's).

Maths



Can you be a Quarter-Hour Queen or Quarter-Hour King for the day (like we do in class): can you tell someone what time it is whenever it gets to an o'clock, half past, quarter past or quarter to time? (Ideally this should be using an analogue (not digital) clock which is what we learn to read in Year 2.
