Horatio Nelson and the Battle of Trafalgar

Why is Nelson famous?



- 1. Horatio Nelson was born on 29th September 1758 in Norfolk
- 2. Nelson showed an early love for the sea and joined the navy at the age of 12.
- 3. Nelson was good at his job because he became a captain at the age of 20. He was one of the youngest-ever captains in the Royal Navy.
- 4. Nelson was considered a great sailor BUT he suffered from seasickness all his life!
- 5. Nelson was injured a number of times. During one battle, he was shot in the right elbow and had to have his arm amputated without anaesthetic by the light of a lantern!
- 6. Nelson's greatest-ever victory was at the Battle of Trafalgar. He and the navy stopped France from invading Britain.
- 7. Nelson died at the Battle of Trafalgar. He was hit by a bullet and died hours later on the 21 October 1805.
- 8. After he was killed, his body was preserved in brandy and sailed back to England.
- 9. His ship is called HMS Victory and you can still visit it in Portsmouth!
