Reading

Can you write some questions using these pirate words? (They can be silly questions!) e.g. (*Did the poor child find a wild tiger behind the sofa?*) Don't forget **capital letters** at the beginning and **question marks** at the end.

Maths



Use your digit cards to make 2-digit numbers. Can you add 10 to your numbers mentally (or using your 100 square to help you).

Challenge: Can you add 20, 30, 40 or other multiples of 10.
