<p><u>Reading & Topic</u></p> 	<p>Read some information about Japan online (or in a book). Write down three facts about what you have learnt. Add pictures if you want to.</p> 
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>Use the same pirate words that you practised last time (<i>poor, door, floor, kind, mind, find, behind, child, children, wild, climb, because</i>)</p> <p>Can you write some <u>commands</u> using these pirate words? (They can be polite or bossy) e.g. (<i>Please mind the hole in floor because you might fall in. Shut the door behind you!</i>) Don't forget capital letters at the beginning and full stop or exclamation marks at the end.</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p>Use your digit cards to make 2-digit numbers. Can you subtract 10 from your numbers mentally (or using your 100 square to help you).</p> <p><i>Challenge: Can you subtract other multiples of 10 (as long as your number is large enough).</i></p>
