English O O O O O O O O O O O O O O O O O O O	Can you remember what instructions are for? They tell us how to do or make something. Can you remember the features that instructions have? Read the instructions below and see if you can spot them. (Can you find 5 things?) Remember you can use your 'bossy' voice! <u>How to brush your teeth.</u> You will need Toothpaste, toothbrush, cup of water, sink. 1. Wet your toothbrush in cup of water. 2. Put a pea size shape of toothpaste on your toothbrush. 3. Keep your teeth together in a wide smile. 4. Brush the front of your teeth up and down. 5. Brush each side of your teeth in the same way. 6. Open your mouth and brush on top of your teeth. 7. Repeat on both sides of your mouth, top and bottom. 8. Brush inside your teeth all the way round. 9. Spit out when you need to into sink. 10.Rinse your mouth out with a drink of water. Have a go at writing a set of instructions for something you do at home every day.
