English

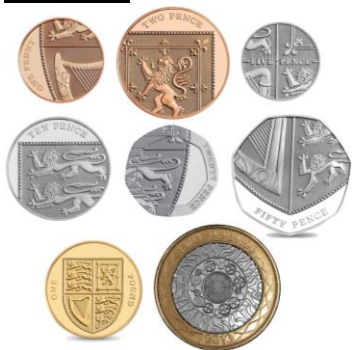


How did you get on with writing some instructions? Did you remember the 5 things or features that instructions have?:
