Art and Craft



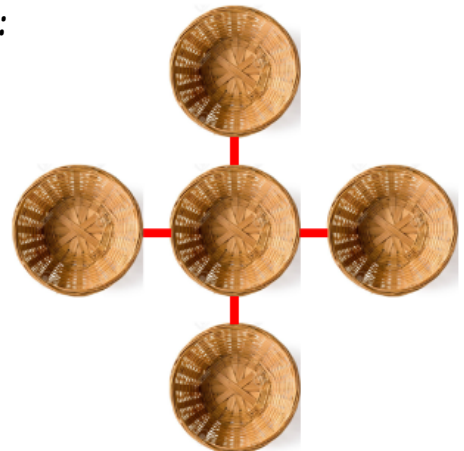
