English Learning Can One Person Change the World?

In English, we will be looking at Space stories and non-fiction books about Space.



- To listen to and discuss stories at a level beyond reading independently
- To participate in discussion about what is read, taking turns and listening to what others say
- To leave spaces between words
- To sequence sentences to form short narratives based on the story, 'The Man on the Moon.'
- To read what has been written out loud, clearly

Mathematical Learning

This term we are looking at:

- Addition & Subtraction
 - to read, write and interpret mathematic
 - involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs
 - add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including 0
 - Number bonds to 10
 - Comparing addition and subtraction statements.
- Place Value
 - Partitioning 10s and 1s and counting 1 more and 1 less
 - Shape
 - Sorting and recognising 2D and 3D shapes

PSHE Learning

We will be exploring personal qualities, strategies to manage feelings, the impact of sleep and relaxation on wellbeing, the importance of hand washing and sun protection, identifying and dealing with allergic reactions and finding out about people in the community who keep us healthy.

Scientific Learning

Our topic this half term is materials. We will:

- Identify what things are made of
- Learn about the properties of materials

Art Learning

We will be learning about printing, using a range of artists to inspire us. We will explore a range of printing techniques such as relief printing and mono printing to create our own space themed, repeating pattern.

We will also be creating a moving picture in DT lessons.



Music Learning

We will be learning a range of songs for our Christmas nativity. Details to follow.

Faith and Wonder Learning

We will be looking at the topic of Incarnation - exploring the question, 'Why is Christmas important to Christians?'

Computing Learning

We are learning how to write instructions to make our rockets fly to the moon. We will have a go writing lists, gathering data, and sequencing the instructions in the correct order.

PE Learning

We will be continuing to focus on invasion games, centred on a fairground theme. In indoor PE, we will continue gymnastics, focusing on movement and balance.
