




Dear Year 1,

Here are some lovely activities for you to try today or tomorrow. These could be done in 10 - 20 min sessions.

<p><u>Reading & Phonics</u></p> 	<p><u>Reading</u> - Read a book for 5-10 minutes today. Inference questions you could ask your child. What do you think.... means? Why do you think that? How has the author made us think that...?</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> - Can you read the question and answer yes or no? https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/yes-no-yeti?phase=5</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p><u>Poetry</u> Can you write your own poem about a picnic? Can you use ideas from the picnic poem you have heard on Seesaw or from your own experience of having a picnic? What food and drink could you write about?</p> <p><i>Challenge - What describing words could you include?</i></p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p><u>Measurement - Mass & weight</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go on a hunt around your home or garden. Collect some objects you could weigh.2. Write three labels. Heavy, Light and equal =3. Hold two objects. One in each hand. Feel how heavy they are.4. Put the objects next to the correct sign. <p><i>You will need your labels again on Thursday.</i></p>
<p><u>Other activities</u> <u>Geography, Computing and Faith and Wonder</u></p> 	<p><u>Geography</u> Watch the second part of the video about the 5 oceans. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gFIS3aLQPfs Can you name and locate the world's 5 oceans? You could look at an Atlas if you have one at home. Draw or paint a place that is special to you, eg: the woods, your garden, the beach. You could say a little prayer to say thank you to God for your special place.</p>
