


Here are some lovely activities for you to try today or tomorrow. These could be done in 10 - 20 min sessions.

<p><u>Reading & Phonics</u></p> 	<p><u>Reading</u> - Read a book for 5-10 minutes today. Retrieval questions you could ask your child. Which is your favourite/worst/funniest/scariest part of the story? Why? Tell me three facts you have learnt from the text. <p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>Today we are going to finish creating a sea creature poster.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Have a look at your poster. What other information could you add? Where could you add some pictures?2. Finish writing facts about the sea creature.3. Now think about adding some pictures, photos or diagrams. You could draw these on another piece of paper then cut them out and stick them onto the poster. Think carefully about the layout.4. When you have finished your poster you could present it and read the information to your family.5. Take a photo and add it to Seesaw. Decide where you are going to display your poster. <p>Remember to use your research to help you.</p>
