Dear Year 1,

Here are some lovely activities for you to try. These could be done in 10 - 20 min sessions.

<p><u>Reading &amp; Phonics</u></p> 	<p><u>Reading</u> - Read a book for 5-10 minutes today. Sequencing questions you could ask your child. What happened at the end of the...? Can you retell the story to me in 20 words or less? What happened before that?</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> - Can you play the capital letter game? <a href="https://www.roythezebra.com/reading-games/capital-letter-1.html">https://www.roythezebra.com/reading-games/capital-letter-1.html</a></p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>We are learning to write our own sea creature story and will be writing each part of our story over the next couple of weeks. Look at your story plan. Can you talk about the beginning of your story to someone in your family?</p> <p>Today we are going to write the beginning of the story. Can you write a title for your story? Can you introduce the main character and the setting of the story? <i>Check you have used capital letters and full stops.</i> <i>Remember don't rush your writing. We are NOT writing about the adventure part today.</i> <i>Challenge - To use adjectives to describe the main character and setting.</i></p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p><u>Addition &amp; Subtraction - Word problems</u> Watch the subtraction video <a href="https://vimeo.com/415826239">https://vimeo.com/415826239</a> Can you work out the answers to the word problems? You could pause the video after each question to give yourself time to work out the answer. You could also draw pictures or write number sentences to help solve each problem.</p> <p><i>Challenge - Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/415826496">https://vimeo.com/415826496</a> Can you work out the answers to the word problems?</i></p>
<p><u>Other activities</u> <u>PSHCE and PE</u></p>   	<p><u>PSHCE</u> Watch the video about dairy. This could help you with your ideas for your sea creature story and your sea creature dance.</p> <p><u>PE</u> Can you create your own dance of a sea creature. How might different sea creatures might move? Choose a piece of music you like and practice these movements in an open space.
