


Dear Year 1,

Here are some lovely activities for you to try today or tomorrow. These could be done in 10 - 20 min sessions.

<p><u>Reading & Phonics</u></p> 	<p><u>Reading</u> - Read a book for 5-10 minutes today. Prediction questions you could ask your child. How do you think that this will end? Who do you think has done it? What might.... say about that? <u>Phonics</u> - Can you play the tricky word game? https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/tricky-trucks?phase=5#</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p><u>Independent Writing</u> Can you edit your independent writing with an adult helping you? Use a different coloured pencil to show the changes you have made? Check you work for...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Correct spelling of Year 1 common exception words.• Capital letters• Full stops• Exclamation marks• Question marks• Can you add describing words? <p><i>Challenge - Can you check your work independently for where you need full stops and capital letters?</i></p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p><u>Measurement - sequencing of events in chronological order</u> Can you sequence events? You could show what you do in the morning, in the middle of the day, the afternoon and evening.</p> <p>* You could make a timetable for the day/next week.</p>
<p><u>Other activities</u> <u>Geography, Physical Education, Art, Cooking</u></p>    	<p><u>Geography - Beach Visit</u> Our new topic is Fun in the Sun. We will be learning about the seaside. We would usually have a school trip to Littlehampton beach. If you are able to, you could visit a quiet beach following the social distancing guidelines.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• You could go on a shell hunt and collect some shells to use for the art activity.• Have a paddle in the sea with an adult (depending on the tide).• Create a beach sculpture.• Have a sandcastle competition!• Take a picnic and eat it at the beach.• Play a game like bat and ball, football. <p><u>Art</u> Observational drawing of shells</p> <p><u>Cooking</u> Can you help prepare a picnic to take to the seaside?</p> <p>The teachers would love to see photos of these on Seesaw.</p>
