Here are some lovely activities for you to try today or tomorrow. These could be done in 10 - 20 min sessions.

Reading & Phonics	Reading - Read a book for 5-10 minutes today. Prediction questions you could ask your child. How do you think that this will end? Who do you think has done it? What might say about that? Phonics - Can you play the tricky word game? https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/tricky-trucks?phase=5#
Writing	Independent Writing Can you edit your independent writing with an adult helping you? Use a different coloured pencil to show the changes you have made? Check you work for • Correct spelling of Year 1 common exception words. • Capital letters • Full stops • Exclamation marks • Question marks • Can you add describing words? Challenge - Can you check your work independently for where you need full stops and capital letters?
<u>Maths</u>	Measurement - sequencing of events in chronological order Can you sequence events? You could show what you do in the morning, in the middle of the day, the afternoon and evening. * You could make a timetable for the day/next week.
Other activities Geography, Physical Education, Art, Cooking Geography	Geography - Beach Visit Our new topic is Fun in the Sun. We will be learning about the seaside. We would usually have a school trip to Littlehampton beach. If you are able to, you could visit a quiet beach following the social distancing guidelines. • You could go on a shell hunt and collect some shells to use for the art activity. • Have a paddle in the sea with an adult (depending on the tide). • Create a beach sculpture. • Have a sandcastle competition! • Take a picnic and eat it at the beach. • Play a game like bat and ball, football.
