Here are some lovely activities for you to try. These could be done in 10 - 20 min sessions.

<p><u>Reading & Phonics</u></p> 	<p><u>Reading</u> - Read a book for 5-10 minutes today. If you are not sure on reading the word you could have a guess. If we know that.... means..., what might... mean? Does the picture help us? Where else could we look for a clue?</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> - Can you read along with Rumble in the Jungle? https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/story-books-and-games/rumble-in-the-jungle/</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>We are learning to write our own sea creature story. Look at your story plan. Can you talk about the end of your story to someone in your family?</p> <p>Today we are going to write the final part of the story. How will the story end? Is the problem solved? Does your character go back home? How is the character feeling? <i>Check you have used capital letters and full stops.</i></p> <p><i>Challenge - To use adjectives to describe the final part of the story.</i></p> <p>Can you read your story to someone in your family? We would love to see photos or hear you read your story on Seesaw.</p>
