


Dear Year 1,

Here are some lovely activities for you to try today or tomorrow. These could be done in 10 - 20 min sessions.

<p><u>Reading & Phonics</u></p> 	<p><u>Reading</u> - Read a book for 5-10 minutes today. Prediction questions you could ask your child. Where do you think.... will go next? What do you think... will say / do next? What do you think this book will be about? Why?</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> - Can you play the phase 5 game? https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/odd-and-bob?phase=5</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p><u>Independent Writing</u> Can you write about something you did during the half term holiday without any help? Remember to have a go at sounding out words you are not sure how to spell.</p> <p><i>Challenge - Can you independently include some adjectives in your work to describe and make your sentences even more interesting to read?</i> <i>Thursday's task will be to edit your work and make changes.</i></p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p><u>Measurement - sequencing of events in chronological order</u> Can you sequence events? You could show what you do in the morning, in the middle of the day, the afternoon and evening.</p> <p>* You could draw a picture of the things you do at different times in the day.</p>
<p><u>Other activities</u> <u>Geography and Science/DT/Maths</u></p>  	<p><u>Geography</u> Watch the first part of the video about the 7 continents. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gFIS3aLQPfs Can you name and locate the world's seven continents? You could look at an Atlas if you have one at home. Or you could find a world map on the internet. https://earth.google.com/web/@0.7.658201.0a.22251752d.35y.0h.0t.0r/data=KAE</p> <p><u>Science/Design Technology/Maths</u> Can you design your own garden? You could use the ideas from your flower hunt to help you decide on the plants. Can you use a ruler or tape measure to measure the shape of the garden? Draw and label the items you would like. <i>Challenge - You could even make your own miniature garden.
