

<u>Writing</u>	Story Writing Finish your dinosaur adventure story. Imagine you found a dinosaur egg in your back garden. What would you do with it? What might happen to the egg? Can you write a beginning, middle and end to your story?
	 At the beginning explain how you found a dinosaur egg! In the middle write an adventure part about what happens to the egg. At the end write about the end of the adventure.
	Challenge - To use descriptive language. Don't forget capital letters and full stops. The teachers would love to see your story on the Seesaw app. We can't wait to read them!
