Dear Year 1,

Here are some lovely activities for you to try today or tomorrow. These could be done in 10 - 20 min sessions.

<p><u>Reading & Phonics</u></p> 	<p><u>Reading</u> - Read a book for 5-10 minutes today.</p> <p>If you are not sure, does the picture help? Where else could you look for a clue?</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> - Play the Odd and Bob game. Click on Revise all! https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/odd-and-bob?phase=4</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p><u>Story Writing</u> Finish your dinosaur adventure story. Imagine you found a dinosaur egg in your back garden. What would you do with it? What might happen to the egg? Can you write a beginning, middle and end to your story?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. At the beginning explain how you found a dinosaur egg!2. In the middle write an adventure part about what happens to the egg.3. At the end write about the end of the adventure. <p><i>Challenge - To use descriptive language. Don't forget capital letters and full stops.</i> The teachers would love to see your story on the Seesaw app. We can't wait to read them!</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p><u>Time - O'Clock</u></p> <p>Now try telling the time in words. Only select O'Clock times for this week. https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/117/telling-the-time-in-words#</p>
<p><u>Other activities</u> <u>Science</u></p> 	<p>Can you grow some cress? https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/makes/mr-blooms-nursery-cressheads</p> <p>Don't worry if you haven't got all of the things in the video. You could always use a yoghurt pot, cotton wool and kitchen roll. https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/makes/down-on-the-farm-make-cress</p> <p>As you grow your cress think about the following questions...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Why are plants useful to people?2. What does a plant need to grow? <p><i>Challenge - You could make a cress diary to show the stages of it growing. You could draw diagrams and label how it is changing.</i></p>



Mr Bloom's Nursery

Cress Heads



You will need

A yogurt pot
Cotton wool
Kitchen roll
Cress seeds
Water
Paint and paint brushes



Remember to ask a grown-up for help

1

Take the label off the yogurt pot and paint a funny face on top.

2

Put some wet kitchen roll in the bottom and put some damp cotton wool on top of that.

3

Evenly spread some cress seeds on top of the cotton wool and press them down gently.

4

Put the pot in a warm place that gets some sunlight, like a windowsill.

5

Watch the cress grow!
This should happen after about 7 days.
